Matthew's account of the Passion and Death of Jesus

This year, we read from Matthew's account of the passion and death of Jesus on Palm Sunday, and his long narrative is dominated by the words of Jesus "all this has happened so that the scriptures may be fulfilled". What happens to Jesus is unjust, but the events that Matthew narrates are not driven by his enemies, but by something deeply mysterious: the fulfilment of the scriptures. Behind the betrayal, the fear, the hatred and the degradation there works the hidden purpose of God, and Matthew wants to make it clear.

After Jesus speaks of the fulfilment of scripture we see the disciples flee; fulfilling the prophecy of Zechariah 'strike the shepherd and the sheep will scatter' –a prophecy Jesus used to speak of himself earlier in the gospel. Judas throwing the coins back into the Temple when he comes to regret his act of betrayal unconsciously echoes another prophecy of Zechariah, who had also thrown down money in the Temple treasury to symbolise the broken covenant between God and Israel.

Through a series of details in the story Matthew shows how psalm 22 was fulfilled by different people: by the soldiers who mocked him and divided his clothes; by the passers by who shook their heads; by the authorities who mocked him, and by Jesus himself, who echoes the psalm in his cry from the cross.

So Matthew makes his powerful point. God is working his purpose out, hidden in the horrors of this vile event, steering it towards his goal, which is life, not death.
