Samuel 3.1-10; 1 Corinthians 6.12-20; John 1.43-51

Today's readings invite us to think about the revelation of Jesus to individuals.

The well known story of the young Samuel hearing the voice of God, while serving Eli in the temple, begins the theme, reminding us how difficult it can be to discern whether we are really hearing the voice of God.

In the gospel Philip and Nathanael are gripped and fascinated by Jesus, yet struggle for words to express why they felt inclined to follow him. This is at the heart of all true faith. In the midst of our confusion and uncertainty there grows the conviction of something solid, lasting and deeply true in the person of Jesus –and a conviction that he is not just a figure from the past, but alive to be encountered today.

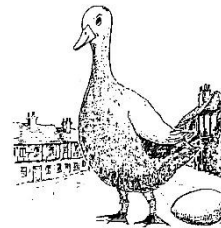
